**URGENT. . .KITS STILL NEEDED!!!!!!**

**HURRICANE DISASTER RELIEF**

*The NorthEast District is concentrating our relief mission on the donations and assembly of HEALTH KITS.*

*Please use the list below in assembling kits for this very special ministry.*

*1 pound ziplock bags: Boxes of large ziplock bags are needed also at the distribution site in order to pack items sent in bulk.*

**HEALTH KIT CONTAINS:**

*1 hand towel (15” x 25” up to 17” x 27”)*

*1 wash cloth*

*1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)*

*1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)*

*1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)*

*1 toothbrush (single brush only in original wrapper; no child-sized brushes)*

*1 large tube of toothpaste*

*(4.5 or larger, expiration date must be 6 months or longer in advance of the date of shipment to Sager Brown)*

*6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages*

*Place all the items listed in a large ziplock bag and bring the kits to the church office. This will be an on-going mission project. Rev. Joe Stiles will see that all kits from Trinity will be delivered to the distribution point.*
