HURRICANE DISASTER RELIEF

The North East District is concentrating our relief mission on the donations and assembly of HEALTH KITS.

Please use the list below in assembling kits for this very special ministry.

1 pound ziplock bags: Boxes of large ziplock bags are needed also at the distribution site in order to pack items sent in bulk.

HEALTH KIT CONTAINS:

1 hand towel (15” x 25” up to 17” x 27”)

1 wash cloth

1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)

1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)

1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)

1 toothbrush (single brush only in original wrapper; no child-sized brushes)

*1 large tube of toothpaste
(4.5 or larger, expiration date must be 6 months or longer in
advance of the date of shipment to Sager Brown)
6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages*

Place all the items listed in a large ziplock bag and bring the kits to the church office. This will be an on-going mission project. Rev. Joe Stiles will see that all kits from Trinity will be delivered to the distribution point.
